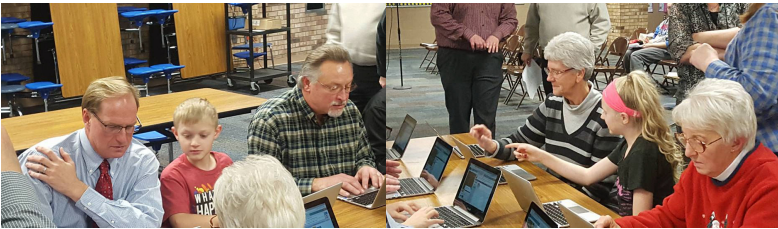


# The Debugging Rebels

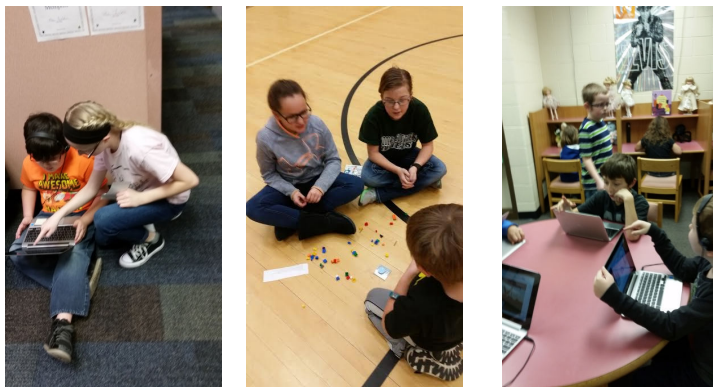
